The following questions are based on Unit 1. Read the unit carefully and answer the questions / solve the exercises given below.

- Q.1 In Unit 1 'Asking and Answering Questions' you have learned different ways of asking or constructing questions and how to answer these questions. On page 11 of Unit 1, there is an exercise No. 1 in which you are asked to construct WH Questions. Do any 5 questions from the 8 given in the exercise. (5)
- Q.2 In the same unit, listen and read recorded text 2 where a traffic police officer is explaining some traffic rules. After reading and listening to this recording, do Exercise 2 and answer the 5 questions. (5)
- Q.3 Go to page 18-19, Exercise 9 and read the dialogue between George and the Waiter. Correct the Waiter's incorrect English or wrong questions by writing the correct questions. (10)
- Q.4 Go to page 24, Exercise 15 and complete the sentences using correct verb to be and present continuous tense. (10)
- Q.5 Go to page 28, Exercise 20 and guess the meaning of the words given in bold in the 10 sentences. (10)

The following questions are based on unit 2. Read the unit carefully and answer the questions / solve the exercises given below.

- Q.6 Go to page 49, Exercise 5 and complete the 5 sentences adding appropriate 'question tags'. (5)
- Q.7 Go to page 58, Exercise 13 and replace the word 'good' in the first 5 sentences with a suitable synonym. (5)
- Q.8 Go to page 69, Exercise 22 and then choose any 1 situation from the 3 given and write an 'informal letter' following the rules and guidelines that we have given in the unit. (10)
- Q.9 Go to page 73 and listen and read recorded text 8. After listening to the text, do Exercise 26 given on page 74 and write the sequence markers Mrs Waseem uses to list the 5 points. (5)

Read the letter of advice to the students of BA English written by Mr Umar Farooq on pages 134-135. After reading the letter, do exercise 17 and write down all the advices that Mr. Farooq has written in the letter. (10)
